The hazards include, but are not limited to condition of participant's boat, equipment, moorings, wharves, boat ramps, carparks, actions of participants, spectators, organiser's personnel and weather conditions. In my judgment I have sufficient competence and experience to participate safely. 2) I hereby take action for myself, my executors, administrators, heirs, next of kin and assigns as follows;
- a) WAIVER, RELEASE AND DISCHARGE from any and all liability for death, disability, personal injury, property damage, property theft, and all other foreseeable risks or claims or actions of any kind, whatever and however occurring which I at any time had or have as a result of or in connection with, directly or indirectly, my participation in and travelling to and from this Event the following persons or entities: Event organisers, Event sponsors, volunteers, community organisations and all State, Federal and Local Government authorities in which the Event may be staged and their (its) respective officers, directors, employees, independent contractors, representatives, agents and volunteers.
